

MATH SUPPLY LIST

The following materials are **required** in Math class and will help ensure success throughout the school year:

- several pencils with erasers; two sharpened pencils should be brought to class each day (I strongly urge students to do math work in pencil)
- eraser caps or extra erasers
- generous supply of binder paper
- a 1 inch three ring binder
- A minimum of a scientific calculator (recommended calculators include, [TI-30X IIS](#), [TI-30Xa](#), [TI-36X II](#), [TI-34 II Explorer Plus™](#))

THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS ARE STRONGLY SUGGESTED:

- One or more of the following for the classroom (to be added to the classroom supplies):
 - Box of tissues
 - Box of 1 inch brass paper fasteners
 - Box of AAA batteries
- Students will be using a graphing calculator in class. To be able to continue working at home a graphing calculator is recommended, but not required. ([TI 83/Plus](#), [TI 84/Plus](#), [TI 84 Plus Silver Edition](#)). This graphing calculator would be instead of a scientific calculator. **Students do not need both.**
- several pens
- a portable manual pencil sharpener with catch-all for shaving
- extra erasers
- a highlighter and/or colored pens for accenting notes
